



BREAKSEA YOUTH ENSEMBLE

Breaksea is pleased to announce Breaksea Youth Ensemble will have two performance streams in 2026; vocal and dance. Meeting weekly during term times, the ensemble will be integrated into Breaksea's upcoming productions. Supported by Healthway, participants will learn singing, dance and performance skills with exciting performance opportunities.

Across Term 1, 2 & 3 the ensemble will work closely with local and visiting performing artists to rehearse and perform in a Music Video of a new commission from electro/pop duo Flood The Moon. In the latter half of Term 3 & Term 4, the ensemble will rehearse and perform in Breaksea & West Australian Opera presents The Song Catchers premiering at Albany Entertainment Centre 23 & 24 October 2026.

The program's themes centre on self-love, connection, bravery and empowerment, rooted in evidence-based research through the Sew-Arts Framework.



ABOUT THE PROJECT

Breaksea Youth Ensemble - Lower Great Southern

Led by Ensemble Director Neville Talbot & Choreographer Jessica Ruggera, together with Breaksea director Pia Harris, participants aged between 9 and 18 years will be provided with opportunities for social connection, participation in singing, dancing & acting activities.

Participation opportunities:

- Weekly sessions held after school at CWA Hall
- Sessions will provide young people with opportunities to participate in:
 - mindfulness, sharing stories and ideas,
 - learning from professional artists (singing, dancing, acting & performance skills),
 - Zoom sessions with Music Director Pia Harris and,
 - Production week with Director Pia Harris.

In Term 1, 2 & 3 we will be learning music & choreography for our Music Video of Flood The Moon's brand new song. In the latter half of Term 3 & Term 4, the vocal performance stream continues learning music from The Song Catchers premiering at Albany Entertainment Centre 23 & 24 October 2026.

Ages: Recommended 9 - 18 years

Vocal & Dance Performance Stream - Participants will be required to sing, act, dance and learn choreography

Vocal Performance Stream - Participants will be required to sing, act, and learn some basic choreography

Dance Performance Stream - Participants will be required to dance, act and learn choreography

Participation fee:

Vocal & Dance Performance stream - Term 1-4 = **\$677.87 including booking fee**

(46 vocal performance sessions and 28 dance sessions including production week

/performances,

total 74 sessions)

Dance Performance stream only - Term 1, 2 & 3 (until 14 August) = **\$286.78 including booking fee**

(28 sessions including production week/performances)

Vocal Performance stream only = **\$469.15 including booking fee** (46 sessions including production week/performances)

Early bird discount for Vocal & Dance Performance streams - Term 1-4 by Friday 30 January = **\$611 including booking fee**

Should I consider this opportunity?

If you love to perform, are keen to develop singing, acting and dancing skills, want to have fun, meet new people and learn more about a future in the performing arts, then YES!

What experience do I need?

No prior experience is needed and there is no need to audition, however, you need to be willing to work hard to develop new skills across singing, acting and dancing.

Do I need to read music?

No, we provide lyrics and sheet music to support all abilities and learning styles.

Am I able to be a part of the rehearsal process but not perform in the music video/ production?

YES! You are able to rehearse and learn the music and not perform in the music video or production.
